Call to Order, Introductions	Meeting commenced at 12:30, followed by introductions and a brief overview of Workgroup.	
Presentation	Adam Wolfe presented on the Veteran’s Jail Diversion and Trauma Recovery Program at Northside Mental Health Center. The program is funded by a SAMHSA grant awarded to Florida, with a local pilot site in Tampa through Northside. The program is staffed entirely by veterans who provide peer specialist services, case management and licensed therapy services to veterans involved in the criminal justice system that are identified with trauma. Northside works closely with the VA to provide diversion and treatment services that include Seeking Safety, with peer supports to increase engagement and develop a trauma-informed system of care.	
Training	Ongoing training continues. Kelly Kelley reported that Adult Protective Services is coordinating a training for June in Tampa and Ft. Myers and will be adding a Trauma Informed Care segment of training for new employees.
