B. It was reiterated that the goal of TIC work groups is for educational purposes, not for treatment and assessment as that should be handled within the individual agencies. It was suggested that an administrative panel be formed in order to field those questions and explain the focus of universal precautions and the importance of deterring re-traumatizing of individuals. Additionally, this panel may include someone who can address the issue of vicarious trauma.
