*Seeking Safety* is an evidence-based treatment for trauma and/or substance abuse. This training provides background on trauma and substance abuse (rates, presentation, models and stages of treatment, clinical challenges); and instruction on implementation of *Seeking Safety* (overview, evidence base, demonstration of the model, adaptation to settings, frequently asked questions, fidelity monitoring and clinician training).

Assessment tools and community resources are also described. By the end of the training, participants can implement *Seeking Safety* in their setting. Learning methods include PowerPoint, video, exercises, and discussion.
