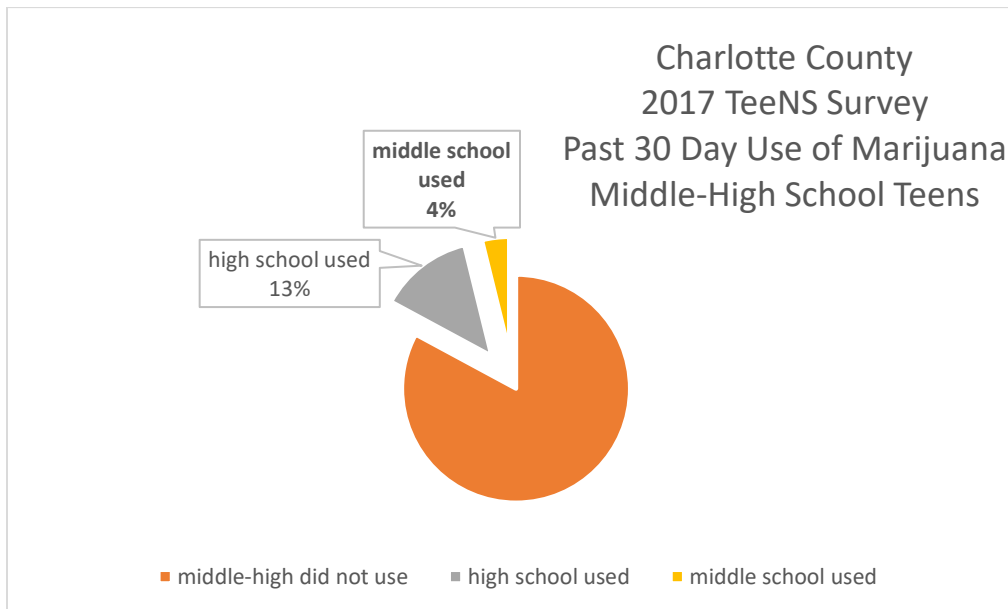
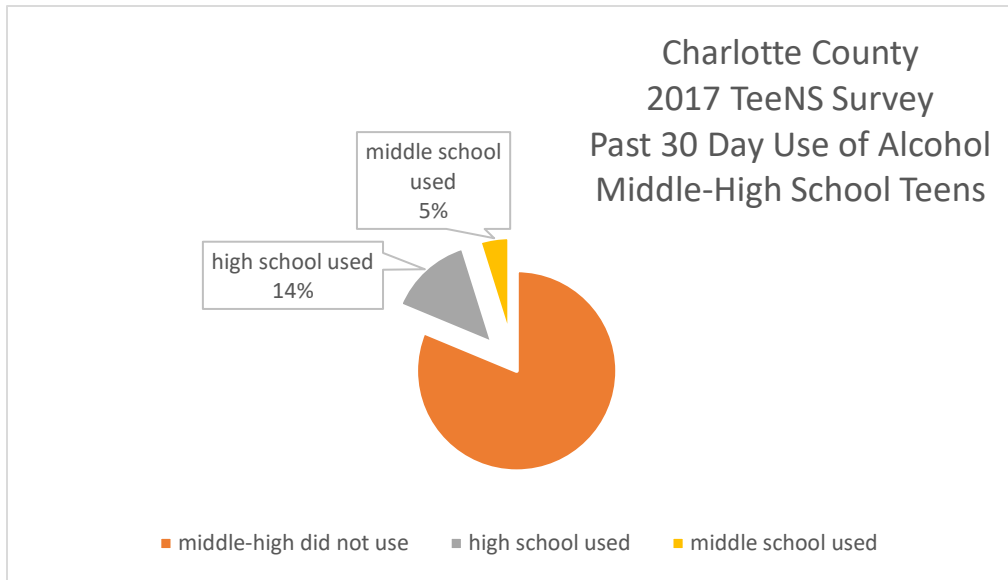
### Key Points from July - June

- Over 12000 children and teens served through prevention activities and services
- Over 30,000 residents reached through media messaging
  - Radio message from Sheriff Prummell on marijuana as medicine
  - Radio message for parents on marijuana
  - Safe Use, Safe Storage, Safe Disposal messages in print and radio media
- Safe Use, Safe Storage, Safe Disposal Initiative Launched
  - Advisory Board formed
  - Website launched – [www.SafeRx.tips](http://www.SafeRx.tips)
  - 20 Physicians joined as Physician Advocates
- Substance Exposed Newborn Task Force
  - Membership expanded
  - Workplan developed through facilitation of Drug Free Charlotte County
  - Kids Thrive! Collaborative developed to target prevention and harm reduction services for pregnant women and children born substance exposed
- Coalition active in community stakeholder groups and partnerships
  - Together Charlotte
  - Healthy Charlotte
  - Substance Exposed Newborn Task Force
  - Kids Thrive! Collaborative

- Policy Changes
  - Civil Citation now requires Life Skills Training (Botvin) from prevention provider
  - Local hospitals giving out Safe Use, Safe Storage, Safe Disposal information at intake

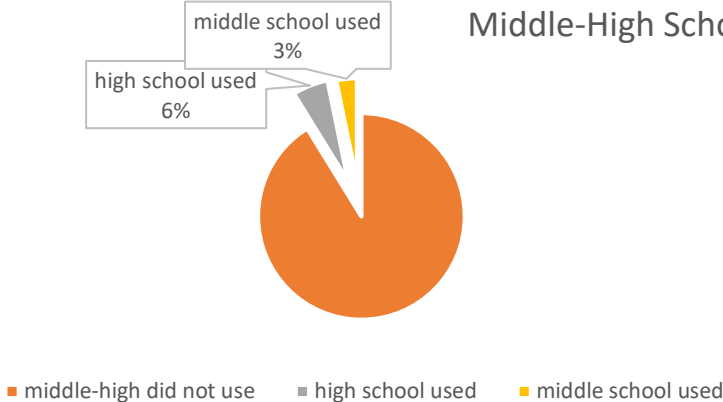
- Expansion of Prevention
  - Life Skills and Strengthening Families Program receiving referrals:
    - Suspension Expulsion Review Team
    - Civil Citation
    - Teen Court
    - DJJ
  - Additional education and skill building sessions provided in elementary schools
  - Parent education provided to young parents as part of collaboration with Early Learning Coalition, Healthy Start and Healthy Families
  - Coalition also facilitated Alateen introduction in several local high schools
  - Teen Safe Driving Workgroup formed (Impaired Driving)
- Special Events hosted by coalition
  - Annual Prevention Breakfast and Awards
  - BaseCamp – Spring Family event
  - Middle School overnigher
  - Trauma Informed Care Train-the-Trainer
  - SRO Luncheon
