- · SLEEPING

• EATING - *PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING*


EXCEPTIONS:

RESPONSE PPE







DON PPE When <u>SAFE</u> to do so

- Out of Chute Time is important
- Response Time is important
- PPE and Provider Safety is <u>PARAMOUNT</u>
- DON PPE on scene.

***Reminder DO NOT HIT ENROUTE UNTIL READY TO MOVE ***

- Cardiac Arrest
- Respiratory Calls
- Pandemic Calls
- Viral Syndrome Calls

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DOFF YOUR PPE ***OUTSIDE*** THE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

AFTER DELIVERY/HANDOFF OF YOUR PATIENT USE THE CHECKLIST ON YOUR AMBULANCE REAR DOORS IF THE ER STAFF IS IN PPE, <u>YOU SHOULD BE IN PPE TOO!</u>



MASK/FACE COVERING
