

Effective the latter of February 19, 2020, or the last date of the signatories, this amends the above-referenced contract as follows:

- Updates FY19-20 Schedule of Funds with changes to OCAs MS919, MH000, MHSFP, MHTA5, MH071, MHCME, MHEDT, MS000, and MSSFP for a total increase of \$459,364.00.
1. Standard Contract, Section 1.1 the contract total, as previously amended by Amendment #0074, is amended to read: \$1,740,858,049.60.
 2. Standard Contract, Section C2-4.5 Early Diversion Team Pilot Project, is added as follows:

The Managing Entity shall implement the Early Diversion Team (EDT) pilot project in Hillsborough County to enhance the effectiveness of the existing Forensic Multidisciplinary Teams in compliance with the provisions of Guidance 28, Section D. The EDT project shall provide jail-based services and supports to adults with non-violent third-degree felony charges to increase early diversion prior to commitment to a state mental health treatment facility.
