PURPOSE:

The SunCoast Region is seeking approval and execution of amendment #0089 to contract QD1A9 with Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc. (CFBHN). As authorized in s. 394.9082, F.S., contract QD1A9 requires the Managing Entity (ME) to subcontract with qualified, direct service, community-based network providers that provide services for adults and children with behavioral health issues in the counties of Charlotte, Collier, DeSoto, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands, Hillsborough, Lee, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, and Sarasota. Amendment #0089 revises the FY21-22 Schedule of Funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Department of Children and Families has contracted with Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc., the Managing Entity (ME), that is responsible for the development, implementation, administration, and monitoring of the behavioral health Safety Net that provides a comprehensive array of behavioral health services to individuals pursuant to s. 394.674. F.S.

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Start/End Date: 7/01/2010 – 6/30/2023
- Total Years of Initial Term: 5 years
- Renewal Options: Renewed for 5 years and an additional 3 years

- Dollar Amount: This amendment decreases the fiscal year total by \$410,210.00, which reduces the fiscal year amount to \$247,007,822.00 and the contract total to \$2,396,857,259.60
- Method of Payment: Advance with fixed fee schedule
- Through budget amendment B-0225, Other Cost Accumulator (OCA) MHC0S, ME Emergency COVID-19 Supp Grant, decreased by \$329,145.00 to \$197,368.00 and OCA MS0TB, Substance Abuse Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, decreased by \$81,065.00 to \$1,579,297.00.
