SERVICES PROVIDED:

The Department of Children and Families has contracted with Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc., the Managing Entity (ME) that is responsible for the development, implementation, administration, and monitoring of the behavioral health Safety Net that provides a comprehensive array of behavioral health services to individuals pursuant to section 394.674, Florida Statutes.

REASON FOR AMENDMENT:

The Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health is seeking approval to amend Contract QD1A9 with CFBHN.

Amendment #102:

- Adds the Schedule of Funds, dated 7/1/2024, by adding \$142,809,239.50, to the contract.
- Adds in appropriation language related to the General Appropriations Act for FY 24-25; and
- Extends the contract for six months, ending 6/30/2025.

KEY PROVISIONS:

CFBHN is tasked with planning, coordinating, and subcontracting for the delivery of community mental health and substance abuse services; improving access to care and promote service continuity; and support efficient and effective delivery of services. Changes related to this Amendment require CFBHN to:

- Apply the Schedule of Funds for FY24-25, dated 7/1/2024, to their budget to continue to fund services.
- Apply the appropriation allocations as outlined in the General Appropriations Act for FY24-25, through contract and budget.
- Continue to operate until 6/30/2025.

C2-15 Fiscal Year 2024-25 Appropriations

Pursuant to the FY24-25 General Appropriations Act, Chapter 2024-231, Laws of Fla., the Managing Entity shall implement the following, summarized in **Table 1**.

C2-15.1 - Specific Appropriation 372

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 372, the following recurring base appropriations project is funded from the General Revenue Fund:

C2-15.2 - Specific Appropriation 374

C2-15.2.1 From the funds in Specific Appropriation 374, \$840,000 from the General Revenue Fund shall be provided to Centerstone of Florida for the operation of a Family Intensive Treatment (FIT) team (recurring base appropriations project).

C2-15.2.2 From the funds in Specific Appropriation 374, the following base appropriations project is funded with recurring funds from the General Revenue Fund:

C2-15.3 – Specific Appropriation 375 Projects

The funds in Specific Appropriation 375 are provided for receiving systems pursuant to section 394.4573, Florida Statutes. Receiving systems consist of one or more facilities serving a defined geographic area and are responsible for assessment and evaluation, both voluntary and involuntary, and treatment or triage of patients who have a mental health or substance use disorder, or co-occurring disorders. Receiving systems provide a single point of entry (central receiving facility) or a coordinated system of entry for an array of behavioral health services, conduct initial assessments and triage, and provide care coordination to link individuals to their needed level of behavioral health care.

C2-15.3.1 From the funds in Specific Appropriation 375, recurring funds from the General Revenue Fund shall fund the existing central receiving facilities.
