6. F.7 is amended to add:

F.7.4 Return and Reconciliation of Unexpended Member Project Funds

F.7.4.1 Annual Reconciliation Requirement

Within 90 days after the end of each State Fiscal Year, the ME shall conduct an annual financial reconciliation of all Member Project funds subcontracted to Network Service Providers. The reconciliation shall account for the total funds disbursed, expended, and obligated during the Fiscal Year.

F.7.4.2 Return of Unused or Unobligated Funds

Any unexpended or unobligated Member Project funds remaining at the conclusion of the Fiscal Year shall be returned to the Department. Returned funds shall not be considered allowable carry forward under Section F.5 and shall not be used for any other purpose without the Department's advance written approval.

F.7.4.3 Supporting Documentation

The Managing Entity shall submit to the Department a Member Project Reconciliation Report, including:

F.7.4.3.1 Detailed accounting of expenditures and obligations by project and fund source.

F.7.4.3.2 Supporting documentation from each Network Service Provider, including expenditure ledgers and final invoices.

F.7.4.3.3 Certification from the ME's Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer (or equivalent) attesting to the accuracy and completeness of the reconciliation.

F.7.4.4 Restriction on Reallocation or Carry forward

Member Project funds shall not be reallocated, retained, or carried forward by the Managing Entity or any Network Service Provider beyond the fiscal year of appropriation, except as expressly authorized in writing by the Department. The Managing Entity must ensure subcontracts include corresponding terms requiring return of unexpended project funds to the ME.

F.7.4.5 Noncompliance

Failure to submit timely reconciliation or return of unexpended funds may result in corrective action or financial consequence.


7. All provisions in the Contract and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Amendment are changed to conform with this Amendment. All provisions not in conflict with this Amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the Contract. This Amendment and all its attachments are made a part of the Contract.
