

## Lease vs. Own

### ***Policy***

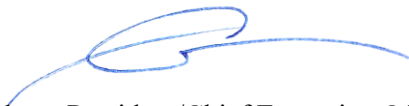
It is the policy of Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc. (CFBHN) to follow the Federal General Procurement Standards (2 CFR 200.318) and adhere to standards in the Federal *Appendix II to Part 200* document. CFBHN analyzes whether to purchase or lease equipment, space, and any other purchases where appropriate.

### ***Purpose***

The purpose of this policy is to outline the procedures utilized in making the decision to lease or purchase.

### ***Procedure***

1. CFBHN seeks a minimum of three quotes to determine whether it is more economical to lease, rent, or purchase.
2. If less than three quotes are received, a written statement as to why additional quotes were not received is prepared and attached to the procurement document.
3. CFBHN follows the guidance as outlined in the *General Procurement and Distribution of Funding and Purchasing* policies.
